Works notification | 9 February 2024

Dear staff and parents/carers,

We are replacing the eaves in an outdoor walkway located outside the Before and After School Care Building (C) at Marks Point Public School.

This work begins with removing asbestos containing material within the eaves, as listed on the school's asbestos register, and replacing the old materials with new durable building materials.

Work to remove the eave sheets is scheduled for Saturday 10 February 2024.

The walkway continues to be used prior to this work as the existing eave material are undisturbed and in good condition.

All work involving asbestos containing materials will take place outside of school hours, with additional safety measures and air monitoring in place before the work starts.

Work will be done in accordance with work, health and safety laws and the NSW Department of Education's Asbestos Management Plan. All work will be completed by licensed and accredited asbestos contractors and monitored by occupational hygienists in strict accordance with all applicable legislation, regulations, policies, and guidelines.

Following removal of the material, the contractor will receive a clearance certificate from the independent hygienist to continue the rest of the work on the walkway.

The health, safety, and wellbeing of the school and local community is our highest priority, and we will continue to keep the community updated.
