Works notification | 12 June 2025

Dear staff, parents and carers,

We are upgrading electrical switchboards at Marks Point Public School.

As part of this work, we are replacing several electrical switchboard backing panels identified as containing bonded asbestos on the school's asbestos register.

NSW Health explains that "living or working with asbestos, or just being around it, is a low risk to your health as long as the asbestos is in good condition and not damaged".

The locations of these panels are:

- entry area in the Administration Building
- canteen storeroom in Building C
- staff toilet in Building B.

Work to replace these panels is planned to take place on Saturday 28 June 2025.

Safety measures will be in place during the work including air monitoring, signage and workers wearing personal protective equipment.

All work involving asbestos-containing materials will take place outside of school hours.

All work will be done in accordance with work health and safety laws and the NSW Department of Education's Asbestos Management Plan. All work will be completed by licensed asbestos contractors and inspected by an independent hygienist before clearance is provided to allow ongoing access.

The health, safety and wellbeing of all members of our school and the local community are our highest priorities.
