Following on from the previous school holiday works notification outlined below, and due to contractor availability, we have had to reschedule the demountable building works at Marks Point Public School.

Work involving asbestos-containing materials has been **rescheduled** and will be completed outside of school hours on **Saturday 23 August 2025**.

This work will be completed with safety measures in place with clearance provided by the independent hygienist.

School holiday works notification – Winter | 2025

Dear staff, parents and carers,

The school holidays are the ideal time to complete maintenance and project work across the state without disrupting learning.

Planned work over the winter break

We will be working at your school during the Winter School Holidays – from the end of the school day on Friday 4 July 2025 up to Day 1 Term 3 (Tuesday 22 July 2025).

We are removing and demolishing a demountable south of buildings E and G at Marks Point Public School, between Thursday 17 and Saturday 19 July 2025.

The demountable was previously used as a staffroom which is now located in a permanent space.

As no one is allowed at the school while this work is happening, the Out of School Hours (OOSH) vacation care will be moved to Blacksmiths Public School for Thursday 17 and Friday 18 July.

This work will involve removing asbestos-containing material identified as bonded asbestos on the school's asbestos register.

NSW Health explains that “living or working with asbestos, or just being around it, is a low risk to your health as long as the asbestos is in good condition and not damaged”.

Safety measures will be in place during the work including air monitoring, fencing, signage and workers wearing personal protective equipment.

Work hours are between 7 am and 5 pm Monday to Friday, and 8 am and 4 pm on Saturday.



All work will be done in accordance with work health and safety laws and the NSW Department of Education's Asbestos Management Plan. All work will be completed by licensed asbestos contractors and inspected by an independent hygienist before clearance is provided to allow ongoing access.

The health, safety and wellbeing of all members of our school and the local community are our highest priorities.
