

Kapooka Public School

School holiday works notification – Autumn | 2025

Dear staff, parents and carers,

We are pleased to advise that scheduled work to demolish the student toilets at Kapooka Public School during the Autumn School Holidays was completed.

During this work we removed known bonded asbestos in the eaves of Building B as identified in the school's asbestos register.

NSW Health explains that “living or working with asbestos, or just being around it, is a low risk to your health as long as the asbestos is in good condition and not damaged”.

All work was done in accordance with work health and safety laws and the NSW Department of Education's Asbestos Management Plan. Safety measures including temporary fencing and air monitoring were in place while work was done. All work was completed by licensed asbestos contractors and inspected by independent hygienists.

The area was inspected by the independent hygienist to confirm it was fully remediated, and a clearance certificate was issued allowing work to continue the toilet block rebuild.

Toilet rebuild

During Term 2 we will be rebuilding the student toilets at Kapooka Public School.

Work will include:

- installation of 6 new toilet cubicles, including 2 ambulant toilets
- installation of stainless-steel step tread boys' urinal
- new handwashing facilities
- new extraction fans.

Alternative toilet facilities are available on the school site near the COLA.

In addition to the toilet rebuild, we will also:

- remove the existing timber fence and replacing with steel fence (outside of the toilet block)
- build a new cleaner's room
- instal new lighting and a window in the cleaner's room.

We will ensure works are carried out safely and efficiently to minimise impacts on the school community.
