Dear staff, parents and carers,

As part of planned work at Belmont North Public School, we will be upgrading an accessible student bathroom and a classroom in Building B. Material in the wall linings of these rooms are known to contain bonded asbestos as listed on the school's asbestos register.

NSW Health explains that 'living or working with asbestos, or just being around it, is a low risk to your health as long as the asbestos is in good condition and not damaged.'

Work to remove asbestos-containing wall linings in these rooms is scheduled to take place on Saturday 16 and Sunday 17 November 2024.

The room upgrades are due to be completed by late November 2024. Alternative facilities and classroom spaces will be available onsite for students and staff to use during this time.

All work involving asbestos-containing materials will take place outside of school hours.

All work will be done in accordance with work health and safety laws and the NSW Department of Education's Asbestos Management Plan. All work will be completed by licensed asbestos contractors and monitored by independent hygienists.

The health, safety, and wellbeing of the school and the local community is our highest priority.
