Crown Street Public School Community update | February 2025

We are delivering a series of projects at Crown Street Public School to improve the facilities for students and staff, including upgrading the boys' and girls' toilets, resurfacing asphalt areas and replacing the soft fall in the playground.

Bathroom upgrade

During the 2024 Spring School Holidays, the school received a significant upgrade to the boys' and girls' toilets. This included installing new tiles on the walls and floor, new windows, new toilets and partitions, and painting the ceiling.

This upgrade was finished in time for students to enjoy in Term 4 2024 and received a lot of positive feedback from the school community.

External ground works

As part of the works being undertaken, all asphalt areas on the school site that are accessible to students and staff are being resurfaced.

Planning to resurface the site is progressing as we consider the heritage features while maximising connectivity and accessibility across the school.

The archaeological team have now completed their investigations and will be preparing their report in the coming weeks. This report will be reviewed by the heritage team and used to assist in developing the scope of works for the resurfacing of the asphalt areas. This scope will then proceed through the approvals process to ensure we comply with the heritage requirements for the site.

Planning to replace the soft fall areas of the playground has progressed and we expect to start these works in Term 1.
