We are delivering a series of projects at Crown Street Public School to improve the facilities for students and staff, including upgrading the boys' and girls' toilets, resurfacing asphalt areas and replacing the soft fall in the playground.

## Update on soft fall replacement

In <u>March 2025</u> we notified you about work to replace the soft fall areas of the playground at Crown Street Public School.

We are pleased to advise the soft fall replacement works are now finished and we will be handing over the project to the school shortly for students to enjoy.

## Remaining external ground works

We are finalising arrangements to resurface the asphalt areas in the school in line with the heritage requirements for the site.

This involves conducting investigations and compiling documentation in order to submit a Section 60 (s60) works application. This is a formal process that thoroughly assesses and provides mitigations for any potential effects of these works on the heritage significance of the site.

We expect to submit the s60 works application to the NSW Heritage Council during the upcoming Autumn School Holidays.

Assessment of the s60 works application can take between 40 and 60 days. Once we receive final approval, the scope of works to resurface the asphalt areas can be finalised.
