Update on soft fall replacement

In [March 2025 we notified you about work to replace the soft fall areas of the playground](#) at Crown Street Public School.

We are pleased to advise the soft fall replacement works are now finished and we will be handing over the project to the school shortly for students to enjoy.

Remaining external ground works

As outlined in our [works notification issued in April 2025](#), we are finalising arrangements to resurface the asphalt areas in the school in line with the heritage requirements for the site.

The work we have completed includes:

- preparation of scope
- heritage assessment
- procurement of archaeological reporting and research design
- lodgement of the Section 60 (s60) works application.

Following approval of the s60 application, the next steps will include test excavation and reporting, procurement, start of works (which includes excavation monitoring from the archaeologist) and post-excavation reporting.

We will be consulting with the school and P&C representatives in Term 3 to provide an opportunity for feedback. We will provide further information on this at the start of Term 3.

We are committed to respecting the history of this special site and appreciate your continued patience and understanding as we progress through this process to allow us to deliver these works for the school.
