## Maclean Public School Works notification | 15 May 2025

Dear staff, parents and carers,

On Saturday 17 May 2025, we are repairing 2 lights in the movement area outside the first floor classrooms in Building I at Maclean Public School.

This work involves removing 5 ceiling sheets known to contain bonded asbestos, as listed on the school's asbestos register.

The ceiling sheets are currently in good condition with no damage. NSW Health explains that "living or working with asbestos, or just being around it, is a low risk to your health as long as the asbestos is in good condition and not damaged".

Once the work to remove the ceiling sheets is finished, an independent hygienist will inspect the work and issue a clearance certificate.

After the ceiling sheets are removed by licensed contractors, they will install plastic to cover the exposed ceiling areas. Students and staff will then be able to access the area until the ceiling sheets are replaced with new material the following week.

Work will take place between the hours of 7 am and 12 pm.

All work will be done in accordance with work health and safety laws and the NSW Department of Education's Asbestos Management Plan. Safety measures will be in place while work is being done. All work will be completed by licensed asbestos contractors and inspected by independent hygienists.

The health, safety, and wellbeing of all members of our school and the local community are our highest priorities.
