Works notification | 18 May 2023

Dear staff and parents/carers,

We are repainting the community and OSHC rooms at Wollongong Public School in Building C. As part of this work, lead containing paint on the walls will need to be stripped before repainting can start.

The rooms are being safely used at present as the paint on the walls is undisturbed.

As a precaution, the rooms will be cordoned off and students and staff relocated before works begin.

Work to remove the paint and repaint the walls will take place after school hours between Thursday 25 May and Thursday 8 June 2023. This will include works to strip the paint on Saturday's when the school is vacant from students, staff and visitors.

All work involving lead containing materials will take place with additional safety measures and monitoring in place before the work starts.

Work will be done in accordance with SafeWork NSW regulations and completed in strict accordance with all applicable legislation, regulations, policies and guidelines.

The community and OSHC rooms will be inspected by an independent hygienist to confirm they have been fully remediated, and the school will receive a clearance certificate before they are reopened to students and staff.

The health, safety, and wellbeing of the school and the local community is our highest priority.
