Works notification | 4 December 2024

Dear parents, carers and staff,

Work to remove the Building C eave sheets at Farmborough Public School has been rescheduled, due to contractor availability, and will now take place from Thursday 19 December to Sunday 22 December 2024.

The removal process will continue as communicated in the below works notification, issued on 27 November 2024.

Delivery of the subsequent roof replacement work **will not be impacted** and will take place during the Summer School Holiday period.

Notification issued 27 November 2024

Dear parents, carers and staff,

Planning is underway to replace the library roof (Building C) at Farmborough Road Public School during the Summer School Holidays.

Eave sheets, which are known to contain bonded asbestos and listed in the school's asbestos register, will be removed on Saturday 14 and Sunday 15 December 2024 ahead of this work.

NSW Health explains living, working or being around asbestos is a low risk to your health if the asbestos is in good condition and not damaged.

Roof works, which will be complete before Term 1, Day 1 2025, will include:

- new roof sheets
- new lining and capping
- replacement gutters, fascia and downpipes.

All work involving asbestos materials will take place outside of school hours with safety measures, including air monitoring, will be in place while work occurs.

The building will be inspected by an independent hygienist to confirm it has been fully remediated and a clearance certificate will be issued before it is reopened.
