Works notification | 4 March 2025

Dear staff, parents and carers,

As part of planned maintenance, we are repairing part of the exterior roof on 2 buildings: Building D and a small section on Building H at Biraban Public School.

The work involves replacing roof materials on these 2 buildings which are known to contain bonded asbestos as listed on the school's asbestos register.

NSW Health explains that 'living or working with asbestos, or just being around it, is a low risk to your health as long as the asbestos is in good condition and not damaged'.

All work involving asbestos-containing materials will take place outside of school hours, on Saturday 22 March and Sunday 23 March 2025. The independent hygienist confirmed that learning and teaching can continue leading up to these works.

During the works there will be air monitoring, temporary fencing, signage and workers wearing personal protective equipment at the school.

All work will be done in accordance with work health and safety laws and the NSW Department of Education's Asbestos Management Plan. All work will be completed by licensed asbestos contractors and monitored by an independent hygienist.

After repairs are finished, the independent hygienist will inspect and provide clearance to continue using both buildings.

The health, safety and wellbeing of the school and the local community is our highest priority.
