Works notification | 15 October 2024

Dear staff, parents and carers,

During a recent inspection during the recent Spring School Holiday period, between 28 September until 13 October 2024, damage to external paint on the upper western-facing wall of Building G was identified at Umina Beach Public School. Testing has confirmed that this paint contains lead. The area was fenced off and isolated from students and staff attending the vacation care program.

Work to remove the damaged lead paint and repaint this area has been scheduled to take place on Saturday 19 October 2024.

All work will be done in accordance with work, health and safety laws. All work will be completed by licensed contractors and monitored by independent hygienists.

Following the work, the building and external area will be inspected by an independent hygienist and a clearance certificate will be issued for the area to be reopened.

The health, safety and wellbeing of the school and the local community is our highest priority.
