### Notification issued 6 May 2026

Dear staff, parents and carers,

The health, safety, and wellbeing of all members of our school and the local community are our highest priorities.

We are removing a demountable toilet building located behind Building D on the south side of Umina Beach Public School.

When no longer needed, demountables are removed to return open play spaces for students to enjoy. This demountable is no longer required by the school and will not be replaced.

Due to the age, condition and known presence of bonded asbestos, the demountable will be safely demolished onsite before it is securely removed on **Saturday 23 May 2026**.

All work involving asbestos containing materials will include safety measures such as personal protective equipment, air monitoring and temporary fencing to restrict public access.

Once removed, an independent hygienist will inspect the area and confirm it can be reopened for school activities.

All work will be done in accordance with work health and safety laws and the NSW Department of Education's Asbestos Management Plan. All work will be completed by licensed asbestos contractors and inspected by independent hygienists.
