Works notification | 12 June 2026

Dear staff, parents, and carers,

On Wednesday 3 June 2026, fragments of material suspected to contain asbestos were found by a member of staff in the garden adjacent to the boys' and girls' toilets in Building F at Richmond Public School.

As a precaution, the area was made out of bounds to students and staff. This location is not in an area identified on the School Asbestos Management Plan (SAMP).

Work to remove the material and clear the surrounding soil will take place on Saturday 20 June 2026 and be completed on the same day.

All work will be done in accordance with work health and safety laws and the NSW Department of Education's Asbestos Management Plan. Safety measures will be place while work is being done. All work will be completed by licensed asbestos contractors and inspected by independent hygienists before the area is reopened.

The health, safety, and wellbeing of all members of our school and the local community are our highest priorities.
