Works notification issued 22 May 2025

Dear staff, parents, carers and neighbours,

As part of our ongoing maintenance in schools, we are undertaking works to address stormwater runoff between Wednesday 21 May and Monday 30 June 2025 at Jannali East Public School.

Part of this work involves installing a pipe across the bush area towards the back of the playground on Saturday 24 May.

This area is known to contain bonded asbestos as listed on the school's Site-Specific Asbestos Management Plan (SSAMP).

NSW Health explains that "living or working with asbestos, or just being around it, is a low risk to your health as long as the asbestos is in good condition and not damaged".

Work hours will be between 7 am and 6 pm Monday to Friday, and 8 am and 2 pm on Saturday. School operations will continue as usual and noise during the works will be kept to a minimum.

The area will be closed off during work hours with temporary construction fencing.

An independent hygienist will be onsite conducting air monitoring throughout the work.

All work will be done in accordance with work health and safety laws and the NSW Department of Education's Asbestos Management Plan. Safety measures will be in place while work is being done. All work will be completed by licensed asbestos contractors and inspected by independent hygienists.

Once the work in this area is completed, an independent hygienist will issue a clearance certificate.

The health, safety, and wellbeing of all members of our school and the local community are our highest priorities. We will keep the community updated.
