

# Jannali East Public School

## Works notification | 3 September 2025

Dear staff, parents, carers and neighbours,

We are installing a mini-golf course within the southern bushland grassed play area at Jannali East Public School.

The area will be made inaccessible with temporary construction fencing while this project is underway.

This area is listed on the school's Site-Specific Asbestos Management Plan (SSAMP) and is regularly inspected.

The first part of this work involves the excavation and removal of soil containing bonded asbestos fragments scheduled for Saturday 13 September 2025. After the soil is removed the independent hygienist will provide clearance for the project to continue under normal construction conditions.

The mini-golf course is expected to be finished by late September 2025, subject to weather and other conditions.

Work will include:

- excavating and disposing of soil containing bonded asbestos fragments with air monitoring in place
- applying a layer of geo-fabric underneath concrete slabs to secure the soil
- installing a mini-golf range and sandstone blocks.

All work will be done in accordance with work health and safety laws and the NSW Department of Education's Asbestos Management Plan. Safety measures will be in place while work is being done. All asbestos removal work will be completed by licensed asbestos contractors and inspected by an independent hygienist.

During the work, there will be an increase in truck and contractor vehicle movements. Construction vehicles will access the site via the designated entrance on Box Road. Some trucks may also access the water pump near the Kingsbury Place boundary during the construction period.

Noisy works will be conducted outside of school hours as much as possible to minimise any disruption to teaching and learning and the local community.
