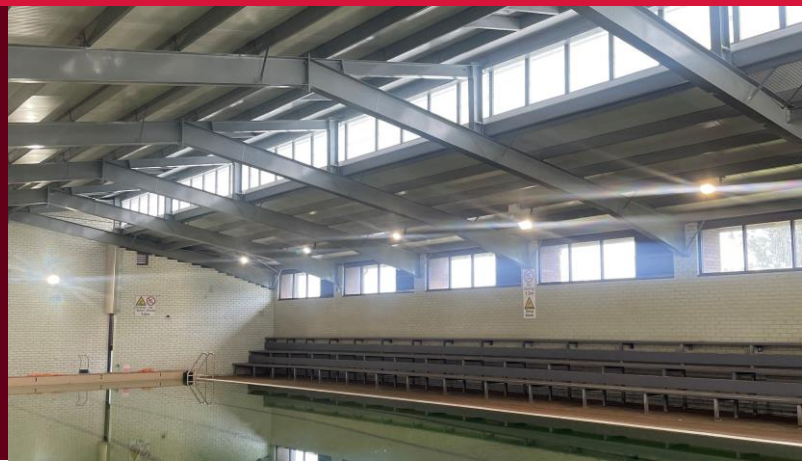


# Peakhurst West Public School - swimming pool Project update | October 2025

## Investing in our schools

As part of the NSW Government's plan to rebuild public education, the NSW Budget is delivering record education funding, including \$9 billion for new and upgraded schools. This targeted investment will ensure growing communities get access to a world class public education.

## Project overview

A project to renovate the swimming pool located on the grounds of Peakhurst West Public School has been delivered.

The Peakhurst West Public School swimming pool has been a valued asset of the St George community since 1961. The pool refurbishment project has enhanced the existing aquatic facility, ensuring its longevity for community groups and students learning to swim.

The swimming pool upgrade included:



Installation of a new accessible bathroom



Thorough cleaning of the pools



Replacement of the roof



Restoration of the pool pumps and plant equipment testing

## Progress summary

The facility was closed in May 2025 to allow for significant refurbishment works to be conducted safely and efficiently.

In that time, we have:

- Completed the roof replacement project, which included removal of asbestos containing materials in the eave linings.

- Installed a new accessible bathroom, which can be used as an alternative change facility when the male/female facilities are closed for cleaning or maintenance.
- Conducted a thorough wash of the wading pool and main pool to ensure the facilities meet operational standards.
- Restored the pumps in the wading and main pools.
- Tested the plant equipment to ensure the facility can meet the needs of the community in the upcoming summer swimming season.

## Pool reopening from Saturday 1 November 2025

We are pleased to announce that the facility will reopen from Saturday 1 November. Bright Pool Services has been appointed as interim site manager to accommodate the needs of community groups and students using the facility.

Please note that the Peakhurst West Public School swimming pool is not a public facility. Access is subject to the terms of Community Use Agreements.

## Expression of interest update

The department received a strong response to the Expression of Interest (EOI) for the pool's upgrade and operation. A select tender process is currently underway, after which the successful applicant will be awarded a licence to upgrade and operate the pool.

Future access arrangements will be determined by the successful operator's proposal and licence conditions, and existing community users will be transitioned by the new operator. We understand this creates uncertainty for current users. We are committed to keeping all community groups informed during this process and will provide as much notice as possible about any changes.

The NSW Department of Education is committed to a fair and equitable Expression of Interest process. We expect to announce a permanent operator in early 2026.
