Investing in our schools

The \$284.3 million [Australian Government Schools Upgrade Fund](#) is delivering grants to improve school facilities across the country. These grants are designed to help schools and their students get back on track after disruptions caused by COVID-19. Public Schools in NSW have a \$68 million share of the fund for infrastructure projects and facility improvements.

Project overview and progress summary

In May 2024, Glenroi Heights Public School was successful in obtaining funding through the Schools Upgrade Fund for a new school hall and multi-sports facility.

The NSW Department of Education has started planning for this new building.

Following a competitive tender process, architects have now been appointed to complete the design of the school hall and sports facility.

Next steps

A concept design will be developed in consultation with school stakeholders, including the Aboriginal Education Consultative Group.

The concept design is expected to be finalised mid-year, when it will be shared with the school community through a project update.

This project is separate to the ongoing rebuild of the administration building and library as documented on the [project webpage](#).

We will continue to keep you updated.
