

Glenroi Heights Public School

Works notification – 9 March 2026

Dear staff, parents and carers,

During planned maintenance works scheduled for the upcoming school holidays, a contractor lifted carpet to inspect the condition of the subfloor and identified green vinyl tiles suspected to contain bonded asbestos in Building H at Glenroi Heights Public School.

NSW Health explains that “living or working with asbestos, or just being around it, is a low risk to your health as long as the asbestos is in good condition and not damaged”.

An independent hygienist was engaged to collect samples of the tiles for testing and advise on remediation. Testing confirmed that the samples contained bonded asbestos. This location is not in an area identified on the School Asbestos Management Plan (SAMP). The register will be updated to include this recent find.

The carpet flooring currently remains in place over the vinyl flooring. The material is in good condition, and the affected rooms remain safe and accessible to staff and students until removal works start.

Planned work over the upcoming holidays

We will be working at your school during the autumn holidays. This period may include from the end of the school day on Thursday 2 April 2026 up to the first day of Term 2 Wednesday 22 April 2026.

As part of these asbestos removal works, known bonded asbestos will be removed from the classrooms 1, 4, 6 and 10 in Building H.

- All work will be done in accordance with work health and safety laws as well as the NSW Department of Education’s Asbestos Management Plan. Safety measures will be in place while work is being done. All work will be completed by licensed asbestos contractors and inspected by independent hygienists, who will provide clearance certificate.
