Works notification | 14 December 2023

Dear staff and parents/carers,

Following on from the works notification on 10 November 2023, we will be doing work during the upcoming school holidays to manage asbestos in ground at Eleebana Public School.

The occupational hygienist has recommended laying additional turf in the fenced area in the north-east section of the playground near Building G as a precaution, to improve the coverage of soil.

Planned work over the Summer school holidays

We will be turfing the areas currently fenced off over the upcoming Summer school holiday period.

This work will take place **during January 2023, and will be finished before the first day of students returning on 1 February 2024.**

Work will be done in accordance with work, health and safety laws and the NSW Department of Education's Asbestos Management Plan. All work will be completed by licensed and accredited asbestos contractors and monitored by occupational hygienists in strict accordance with all applicable legislation, regulations, policies, and guidelines.

These areas are intended to be reopened for use in Term 1, 2024, after the new grass has established.

The health, safety, and wellbeing of the school and local community is our highest priority, and we will continue to keep the community updated.
