# Cringila Public School

#### Welcome to your improved school

Since May 2025 we have been working on a remediation project at Cringila Public School to address concerns related to historical landfill material in the fenced off area of the school grounds.

Throughout this time contractors have installed fencing, new walls, capping layers and new monitoring wells before re-turfing the area so that the school community can use the space again.

We are thrilled to announce that these works at Cringila Public School have reached completion.

This project delivered:



a new multi-layer protective cap, topped with turf to stop oxygen from reaching the coal wash beneath



a new boundary fence, extended internal fence and a tall fence for the new open field area, to catch sports balls



new gabion walls – rocks held in wire mesh that allow water to drain while supporting the area as a strong retaining wall



new monitoring wells to check environmental conditions



- Final testing was completed and independent experts will finalise their recommendations for the area's long-term maintenanceTemporary fencing around the area is to protect the new turf while it establishes.
- The area will remain closed while the grass grows to a suitable condition for school activities to avoid damaging the surface.
- The new turf will have limited access for some students and staff in Term 4 2025. Full use of the area is planned for Term 1, 2026 with scheduling details to be communicated by the school.
