

Lindsay Park Public School

Works notification | 9 February 2026

Dear staff, parents and carers,

The health, safety, and wellbeing of all members of our school and the local community are our highest priorities.

On Thursday 5 February 2026, the ceiling in the cleaner's storeroom in Building K unexpectedly collapsed at Lindsay Park Public School. No one was present at the time.

The ceiling lining in Building K is known to contain bonded asbestos as listed on the School Asbestos Management Plan. Removal works took place on Saturday 7 February 2026. The area was already cordoned off and was not accessible to staff or students.

NSW Health explains that "living or working with asbestos, or just being around it, is a low risk to your health as long as the asbestos is in good condition and not damaged".

All work was done in accordance with work health and safety laws and the NSW Department of Education's Asbestos Management Plan. Safety measures, including temporary fencing, signage and workers wearing personal protective equipment, took place while work was being done. All work was completed by licensed asbestos contractors and inspected by independent hygienists, who provided a clearance before the room was reopened for use.
