Works notification | 5 June 2026

Dear staff, parents and carers,

The health, safety, and wellbeing of all members of our school and the local community are our highest priorities.

Recently we engaged an independent hygienist to conduct investigations into the vinyl tiles underneath the carpet in two classrooms in Building A at Point Clare Public School.

This involved collecting material in the tiles suspected to contain asbestos for testing and provide advice. Testing confirmed that the tiles contain bonded asbestos.

The vinyl tiles in both classrooms are undisturbed and in good condition. NSW Health explains that "living or working with asbestos, or just being around it, is a low risk to your health as long as the asbestos is in good condition and not damaged".

This location was not identified on the School Asbestos Management Plan (SAMP). The asbestos register will be updated to include this recent find.
