

Lilli Pilli Public School

Works notification | 7 November 2025

Dear staff, parents, carers and neighbours,

As outlined in the [Community Update - October 2024](#), we are constructing new student toilet facilities at the back of Lilli Pilli Public School. These new toilets are expected to be finished and opened for use later this month.

This work involves demolishing the existing student toilets, adjacent storerooms and bubblers in buildings F, G and H. These buildings are located on the northern side of the school near the sports courts.

To prepare for demolition works, we will be removing the eave linings and ceilings which are known to contain bonded asbestos as listed on the school's asbestos register.

NSW Health explains that "living or working with asbestos, or just being around it, is a low risk to your health as long as the asbestos is in good condition and not damaged".

Work to remove asbestos-containing materials will be done over consecutive weekends between Saturday 22 and Saturday 29 November 2025.

Following asbestos removal works, we will be demolishing the existing toilet blocks. These toilet blocks will remain fenced off within a construction zone. During the asbestos removal work there will be air monitoring, temporary fencing, signage, and workers wearing personal protective equipment at the school.

All work will be done in accordance with work health and safety laws and the NSW Department of Education's Asbestos Management Plan. All work will be completed by licensed asbestos contractors and inspected by an independent hygienist.

Work hours

Demolition work is planned to be completed by mid-December 2025. Work will take place between 7 am and 6 pm, Monday to Friday and 8 am and 1 pm on Saturday. No work will take place on Sundays or public holidays.

There will be some noise while work is taking place. We are committed to managing noise in line with regulatory requirements and will make every effort to ensure works are carried out safely and efficiently with minimal disruption to the community.
