Mount Ousley Public School Works notification | 12 June 2025

Dear parents, carers and staff,

As part of our planned maintenance work, we will be refurbishing the boys' toilets on the north side of Building A at Mount Ousley Public School.

The boys' toilets will be closed from Monday 23 June 2025. We anticipate the toilets will be finished and reopened to students by the beginning of Term 3, Tuesday 22 July 2025. Students can use alternative toilet facilities across the school while this work takes place.

Asbestos removal

This work will involve the removal of asbestos-containing ceiling panels before the toilets are replaced with new ceilings. The panels are currently undisturbed and in good condition.

NSW Health explains that "living or working with asbestos, or just being around it, is a low risk to your health as long as the asbestos is in good condition and not damaged".

All work involving asbestos-containing materials will take place over 2 weekends between Saturday 21 June and Sunday 29 June 2025.

During the asbestos removal work there will be air monitoring, signage and workers wearing personal protective equipment at the school.

All work will be done in accordance with work health and safety laws and the NSW Department of Education's Asbestos Management Plan. All work will be completed by licensed asbestos contractors and inspected by an independent hygienist to confirm they have been fully remediated, and a clearance certificate issued before the work continues to refurbish the toilets.

The health, safety and wellbeing of all members of our school and the local community are our highest priorities.
