

Albion Park Rail Public School

Works notification | 18 December 2025

Dear staff, parents and carers,

The health, safety, and wellbeing of all members of our school and the local community are our highest priorities.

Following a routine inspection on Wednesday 24 September 2025, water was found underneath the support unit classroom in Building D at Albion Park Rail Public School. On Friday 26 September 2025, an independent hygienist visited and undertook precautionary air quality testing and samples for suspected mould.

On Wednesday 3 October 2025, testing results confirmed the presence of mould. Following air monitoring results, the hygienist advised the classroom could remain in use during the cleaning process. Due to contractor availability, the cleaning work started one week after the testing.

All work involving mould took place outside of school hours, with appropriate safety measures in place.

NSW Health advises that mould is present virtually everywhere, both indoors and outdoors, and is part of a group of very common organisms called fungi that also include mushrooms and yeast. Further information can be found on the [NSW Health Mould Factsheet](#).

The students and staff of the support unit classroom in Building D relocated to Class Lemon in Building A on Tuesday 18 November 2025, ahead of planned classroom relocations for the 2026 school year. The move was timed to coincide with the availability of the specialist contractor so that full remediation of water damage and mould could be completed with a minor effect on learning.
