

Campbelltown North Public School

Community update | 9 September 2025

Dear parents, carers and staff,

A recent state-wide review of government-owned properties identified the land at 2 Thomas Street (see map overleaf) as a site for potential future repurposing. The review has been led by the Government's central property agency, Property and Development NSW, with the assistance of the Cabinet Office.

We understand that this space is currently being used by the school community for parking, drop-off and pick-up activities.

As part of the review process, contractors will be assessing the land on Thomas Street, which will include monitoring vehicle use in the area. The assessment will take place between Monday 15 September and Friday 19 September 2025 and involve cameras being set up to monitor vehicles entering and exiting the area. The monitoring will not involve the recording of any personal details, such as numberplates.

This is an early-stage assessment and there are no immediate changes to parking or drop-off/pick-up arrangements.

Should any future changes be proposed, the department will work with the school to ensure alternative arrangements are in place.

The safety of students, families, and staff is our priority, and we will continue to keep the community informed as more information becomes available.
