Dear staff, parents and carers,

The health, safety, and wellbeing of all members of our school and the local community are our highest priorities.

We are refurbishing the staff bathroom facilities in Building F at Garden Suburb Public School.

This project involves refurbishing the staff toilets by replacing the existing partitions, floor covering and fixtures, fittings and finishes and installing new water-efficient improvements including toilets, urinals, basins and taps.

This work will include removing known bonded asbestos from the ceiling linings as listed on the School Asbestos Management Plan (SAMP).

Work to remove asbestos-containing materials will take place on Saturday 9 March 2026 with safety measures in place.

All work will be done in accordance with work health and safety laws and the NSW Department of Education's Asbestos Management Plan. All work will be completed by licensed asbestos contractors and inspected by independent hygienists.
