

Kent Road Public School

Works notification | 6 November 2025

Dear staff, parents and carers,

We have found and since removed asbestos-containing materials in the grassed area behind Building A at Kent Road Public School.

When the material was discovered, we immediately cordoned off the area with temporary barriers and engaged an independent hygienist to test a sample. The area where the fragments of material were found is not being used.

Testing confirmed that the sample contained bonded asbestos. NSW Health explains that “living or working with asbestos, or just being around it, is a low risk to your health as long as the asbestos is in good condition and not damaged”.

The location where the fragments were found is not identified on the School Asbestos Management Plan (SAMP). The plan will be updated to include these recent finds as required.

All asbestos-containing materials will be removed shortly under the guidance of an independent hygienist who will issue a clearance certificate when the area can be reopened.

The Out of School Hours care has not been affected.

All work was done in accordance with work health and safety laws and the NSW Department of Education’s Asbestos Management Plan. Safety measures were in place while work was done. All work was completed by licensed asbestos contractors and inspected by independent hygienists.

The health, safety, and wellbeing of all members of our school and the local community are our highest priorities. Thank you for your cooperation during this important work.

Did you know?

In 2021, Kent Road Public School received a major upgrade which delivered 34 new permanent teaching spaces, a new library, extension to the hall and multi-purpose sports court, among other facilities.
