Works notification | 2 February 2026

Dear staff, parents, carers and neighbours,

A refurbishment project is currently underway at Truscott Street Public School, delivering modern, fit-for-purpose bathrooms for students.

As notified on [the School Holiday Works webpage](#), the project commenced over the summer break. While it was originally planned to be finished shortly after students returned to school for Term 1, additional work identified during demolition required further action.

During the works, termite damage was discovered throughout the toilet block within key structural beams. To ensure the safety and long-term integrity of the building, the scope of works was expanded to include the construction of a new roof.

As a result, the timeline has been extended, and temporary toilet facilities will be in place while works are completed. These facilities are fully serviced, cleaned regularly and meet all required health and safety standards.

While the temporary amenities are a short-term measure, the outcome will be a completely renewed bathroom facility, delivering significantly improved, durable and modern amenities for the school community.

The health, safety, and wellbeing of all members of our school and the local community are our highest priorities.
