Dear staff, parents and carers,

As part of planned maintenance, we are upgrading the school canteen in the Administration Building at Albert Park Public School.

We wrote to you about these upgrades before the [spring holidays in 2025](#), but due to unforeseen circumstances, work was delayed.

Planned work starting in Term 2

We will start upgrading the canteen by removing ceiling sheeting and footings known to contain bonded asbestos as listed on the school's asbestos register in the Administration Building.

Work to remove asbestos containing materials will take place from early May 2026. The material is currently undisturbed and in good condition.

All work involving asbestos containing materials will take place outside of school hours with safety measures such as PPE, air monitoring and temporary fencing in place.

Work hours are between 7 am and 6 pm Monday to Friday, and 8 am and 1 pm on Saturday, in line with NSW Environment Protection Authority guidelines.

All work will be done in accordance with work health and safety laws and the NSW Department of Education's Asbestos Management Plan. Safety measures will be in place while work is being done. All work will be completed by licensed asbestos contractors and inspected by independent hygienists.

During Term 2, construction of the new canteen will continue. From May, please use the temporary access path marked on the map below to enter and exit the school.

Work is expected to finish in the winter school holidays, and we look forward to welcoming the community back to a new canteen in Term 3, 2026.
