School holiday works notification – Spring | 2025

Dear staff, parents and carers,

As part of planned maintenance, we are upgrading the school canteen in the Administration Building at Albert Park Public School.

Planned work over the upcoming holidays

We will start upgrading the canteen by removing ceiling sheeting and footings known to contain bonded asbestos as listed on the school's asbestos register in the Administration Building during the spring holidays – from the end of the school day on **Friday 26 September 2025 up to Day 1 Term 4 Tuesday 14 October 2025**.

NSW Health explains that “living or working with asbestos, or just being around it, is a low risk to your health as long as the asbestos is in good condition and not damaged”.

Safety measures will be in place during the work including air monitoring, signage and workers wearing personal protective equipment.

The material is currently undisturbed and in good condition.

All work will be done in accordance with work health and safety laws and the NSW Department of Education's Asbestos Management Plan. Safety measures will be in place while work is being done. All work will be completed by licensed asbestos contractors and inspected by independent hygienists.

Work continuing in Term 4, 2025

During Term 4, construction of the new canteen will continue. From October, please use the temporary access path marked on the map below to enter and exit the school.

While the area is closed, the teacher's staffroom will act as a temporary canteen on Fridays.

Work is expected to finish in the summer holidays and we look forward to welcoming the community back to a new canteen in Term 1, 2026.

Work hours are between 7 am and 6 pm Monday to Friday, and 8 am and 1 pm on Saturday, in line with NSW Environment Protection Authority guidelines.
