Valentine Public School School holiday works notification – Autumn | 2025

Dear staff, parents and carers,

The school holidays are the ideal time to complete maintenance and project work across the state without disrupting learning.

Planned work over the Autumn School Holidays

As part of planned maintenance, we are conducting maintenance, including brickwork repairs and concreting, in Building F (a student toilet and general classroom block) at Valentine Public School.

This work will begin on 31 March 2025 and continue until mid 2025. One classroom in Building F has been relocated to an alternative classroom at the school to prepare for this work.

As part of this project, we will be removing and replacing external roof material known to contain asbestos, as listed on the school's asbestos register, in Building F on Thursday 17 April 2025.

NSW Health explains that 'living or working with asbestos, or just being around it, is a low risk to your health as long as the asbestos is in good condition and not damaged'.

Vacation care will be offsite on an excursion on Thursday 17 April 2025 when the asbestoscontaining material is being removed.

During the works there will be air monitoring, temporary fencing, signage and workers wearing personal protective equipment at the school.

All work will be done in accordance with work health and safety laws and the NSW Department of Education's Asbestos Management Plan. All work will be completed by licensed asbestos contractors and monitored by an independent hygienist.

The health, safety, and wellbeing of all members of our school and the local community are our highest priorities.
