Works notification | 11 September 2025

Dear staff, parents, carers and neighbours,

In response to recent weather conditions, we are conducting investigations into the health and stability of trees at Bert Oldfield Public School.

We would like to provide you with information on termite treatment work and an upcoming arborist inspection.

A pest inspection for termites in trees was conducted on Wednesday 10 September 2025.

During this inspection approximately 10 trees within the western boundary of the school were identified to contain termite activity.

The affected trees will be treated by a professional pest controller from Saturday 13 to Sunday 14 September 2025.

Termite treatment works will be carried out within the school grounds safely and efficiently to minimise impacts to the community.

Following this treatment, a qualified independent arborist will attend the school to inspect the trees and provide recommendations for any further actions, which may include tree pruning or removal. The inspection will be scheduled as soon as a qualified arborist is available.

The health, safety and wellbeing of all members of our school and the local community are our highest priorities.
