Dear staff, parents and carers,

As part of the department's proactive asbestos resurvey program, we are replacing a wall lining in an electrical distribution cupboard in Building B (a general classroom block) at Biddabah Public School.

This cupboard is only accessed by electricians.

This work will involve removing asbestos-containing material recently identified as bonded asbestos on the school's asbestos register.

NSW Health explains that "living or working with asbestos, or just being around it, is a low risk to your health as long as the asbestos is in good condition and not damaged".

Work to replace the wall lining is planned to take place on Saturday 24 May 2025.

Safety measures will be in place during the work including air monitoring, signage and workers wearing personal protective equipment.

All work involving asbestos-containing materials will take place outside of school hours.

All work will be done in accordance with work health and safety laws and the NSW Department of Education's Asbestos Management Plan. All work will be completed by licensed asbestos contractors and inspected by an independent hygienist before clearance is provided to allow ongoing access.

The health, safety and wellbeing of all members of our school and the local community are our highest priorities.
