Dear staff, parents and carers,

We are upgrading the student toilets in buildings E and F at Glendale East Public School.

The toilet facilities in these buildings will be closed during Term 2 while construction is underway. Alternative toilets are available for student use in other parts of the school.

The toilet upgrade is expected to be finished and available for student use in time for Term 3.

Asbestos removal work

The health, safety, and wellbeing of all members of our school and the local community are our highest priorities.

To prepare for these works, we need to remove known bonded asbestos containing material (ACM) from the ceiling and wall linings of the kindergarten toilet in Building E, as listed on the School Asbestos Management Plan (SAMP).

Work to remove the ACM linings is scheduled to take place on Saturday 2 May 2026.

All work involving asbestos containing materials will be done in accordance with work health and safety laws and the NSW Department of Education's School Asbestos Management Plan.

Safety measures will be in place while work is being done. All work will be completed by licensed asbestos contractors and inspected by independent hygienists.

Asbestos was used widely in Australian building materials before 1990. We manage the presence of asbestos in NSW public schools by maintaining an Asbestos Management Plan for each school and engaging independent hygienists for expert advice.
