Works notification | 23 March 2026

Dear staff, parents and carers,

A severe weather event on Tuesday 17 March 2026 has caused water to enter the administration area, hallway, classroom and withdrawal spaces in Building A at Gosford East Public School, resulting in damage to the carpet.

Building A has been isolated from students and staff and alternative rooms within the school have been made available until the flooring can be cleaned and repaired.

Work to replace the flooring and environmentally clean all affected surfaces in this building started from Wednesday 18 March and will continue to Friday 27 March 2026, after which the building will be reopened for normal use.

The health, safety, and wellbeing of all members of our school and the local community are our highest priorities.
