

Lynwood Park Public School

Works notification | 1 March 2024

Dear staff, parents/carers,

On Thursday 29 February, during a routine inspection of the school site, two fragments of material suspected to contain asbestos were found at Lynwood Park Public School. Please note that this is not related to the mulch investigation that is being led by the Environment Protection Authority.

The fragments were found in two locations. One fragment was found in a garden bed alongside the fence line in the school carpark and the second fragment was found on the ground between the student toilet blocks located alongside buildings I and H. Both sites were immediately fenced off and made out of bounds.

An independent hygienist attended the site on Friday 1 March, removed the fragments and inspected the area. Testing of the fragments is now underway, and we will advise of the results as soon as they are available.

Work was done in accordance with work, health and safety laws and the NSW Department of Education's Asbestos Management Plan. All work was completed by an independent hygienist in strict accordance with all applicable legislation, regulations, policies and guidelines.
