Works notification | 11 April 2024

Dear staff and parents/carers,

On 26 March 2024 a door handle and surrounding wall lining panel known to contain asbestos material was damaged in a staff toilet in Building A at Tarro Public School.

As a precaution, the toilet was immediately cordoned off and an independent hygienist was engaged to provide remediation advice and install air monitoring.

Following advice from the hygienist, work to remove and replace the toilet wall has been scheduled for Monday 15 April 2024 **during the autumn school holidays**.

Before the toilet is reopened, it will be inspected by an independent hygienist and the school will receive a clearance certificate.

Work will be done under the supervision of an independent hygienist with additional safety measures and air monitoring in place before the work starts.

All work will be done in accordance with work, health and safety laws and the NSW Department of Education's Asbestos Management Plan. All work will be completed by licensed and accredited asbestos contractors and monitored by independent hygienists in strict accordance with all applicable legislation, regulations, policies, and guidelines.

The health, safety, and wellbeing of the school and the local community is our highest priority. We will keep the community updated.
