## School holiday works notification – Autumn 2026

Dear staff, parents and carers and neighbours,

The health, safety, and wellbeing of all members of our school and the local community are our highest priorities.

School holidays are the ideal time to undertake maintenance and project work across the state without disrupting learning.

We are pleased to inform you we are replacing the carpet and vinyl flooring in the Administration Building at Hornsby Heights Public School. As part of this work, vinyl tiles under the existing carpet in rooms 16, 18, 21, 23, 24, 25, 26 and vinyl flooring in the staffroom will be removed.



These vinyl tiles are known to contain bonded asbestos as listed on the School Asbestos Management Plan (SAMP).

Starting in the autumn school holidays, all asbestos-containing materials will be removed with safety measures in place. We expect to finish the work by the start of Term 2, 2026, weather permitting.

Work hours are between 7 am and 6 pm Monday to Friday, and 8 am and 1 pm on Saturday, in line with NSW Environment Protection Authority guidelines.

All work will be done in accordance with work health and safety laws and the NSW Department of Education's Asbestos Management Plan. Safety measures will be in place while work is being done. All work will be completed by licensed asbestos contractors and inspected by independent hygienists.

The rooms will be inspected by the independent hygienist and a clearance certificate will be issued before the rooms are reopened.
