## Marayong Heights Public School Works notification | 26 June 2024

Dear staff, parents and carers,

On Monday 17 June 2024, an independent hygienist found fragments of material with bonded asbestos, while carrying out a scheduled inspection, on the grounds of Marayong Heights Public School.

The hygienist removed the material, which was found in an out of bounds area near the fence line at the back of the school.

No further fragments were found during a follow-up inspection on Tuesday 25 June 2024. The hygienist has issued a clearance certificate for the area.

NSW Health explains if bonded asbestos is mixed with cement, or other hard bonding materials, and in good condition, it is likely to be low risk.

All work was done in accordance with work, health and safety laws and the NSW Department of Education's Asbestos Management Plan.

This work was conducted by an independent hygienist in strict accordance with all applicable legislation, regulations, policies, and guidelines.
