Works notification | 17 March 2026

Dear staff, parents and carers,

We will begin upgrading the flooring in the Building F paper storeroom at Holsworthy Public School from 3 pm on Thursday 19 March 2026.

As part of this work we will be removing bonded asbestos known to be in the vinyl tiles as per the Schools Asbestos Management Plan.

The storeroom will be locked to students and staff while this work is completed.

NSW Health explains that “living or working with asbestos, or just being around it, is a low risk to your health as long as the asbestos is in good condition and not damaged”.

All work involving asbestos-containing materials will take place with safety measures in place.

All work will be done in accordance with work health and safety laws and the NSW Department of Education’s Asbestos Management Plan. Safety measures will be in place while work is being done. All work will be completed by licensed asbestos contractors.

The room will be inspected by the independent hygienist to confirm the asbestos has been removed, and a clearance certificate will be issued before the room is reopened.

The health, safety, and wellbeing of all members of our school and the local community are our highest priorities.
