Dear staff, parents and carers,

As part of our planned maintenance routine, we are planning on removing a shed on the grounds near Building N at Holsworthy Public School. The shed is locked to prevent access and remains out of bounds to students and staff.

To prepare for the removal, we inspected the school grounds and staff identified a cracked ceiling in the General Assistant's storeroom in Building C. The ceiling in the storeroom is known to contain bonded asbestos as listed on the school's asbestos register.

Access to the storeroom was immediately closed and remains out of bounds to students and staff.

Work to remove the shed and replace the cracked ceiling will take place on Saturday 24 May 2025.

All work will be done in accordance with work health and safety laws and the NSW Department of Education's Asbestos Management Plan. Safety measures, including air monitoring, signage and workers wearing personal protective equipment (PPE) will be in place while work is being done. All work will be completed by licensed asbestos contractors and inspected by independent hygienists.

Once the remediation work is completed for the storeroom, an independent hygienist will inspect the work and issue a clearance certificate before the area is reopened for use.

The health, safety, and wellbeing of all members of our school and the local community are our highest priorities.
