

Yarrawarrah Public School

Works notification | 26 September 2023

Dear community,

The health, safety and wellbeing of the school and the local community is our highest priority.

To minimise the risk of bushfire, we will be removing overgrown vegetation on land owned by the Department of Education that is on the western boundary of Yarrawarrah Public School.

Work will take place between 6am and 5pm on **Saturday 30 September** and involve removing dead or fallen trees to increase the gap between vegetation and nearby properties. The exact location of the work zone is shown on the map overleaf.

To remove the vegetation once cleared from the site, we will use heavy machinery, including a truck, woodchipper and a mobile crane.

We will install this crane on Sladden Road to provide access to the western boundary of Yarrawarrah Public School.

We will take all care to minimise noise and disruption to the surrounding community during this work. To ensure the safety of the community and to minimise disruption, we will also have traffic controls in place on Sladden Road.

We have engaged qualified contractors, who will operate under the guidance of an independent arborist in accordance with SafeWork NSW regulations, to carry out this work. All work will be in accordance with all applicable legislation, regulations, policies and guidelines.

We thank you for your patience and understanding while we carry out this important work.
