

Ringrose Public School

Works notification | 19 June 2026

Dear staff, parents, carers and neighbours,

We are upgrading the Administration Building and buildings E and I at Ringrose Public School.

As part of this work, we are replacing floor coverings in the following areas:

- Building E
 - three classrooms on the ground floor
 - three storerooms on the ground floor
 - three classrooms on the first floor
 - four storerooms on the first floor
 - movement area on the first floor
- Building I
 - storeroom on the first floor
 - classroom on the first floor

We are also replacing linings in the staff bathroom walls in the Administration Building.

Existing vinyl tiles and wall linings in these areas are assumed to contain bonded asbestos, as listed on the School Asbestos Management Plan (SAMP). Licensed asbestos contractors will remove them with safety measures in place while staff and students are not at the school. An independent hygienist will inspect the areas and issue a clearance certificate before we reopen the areas.

Work to remove asbestos containing materials will take place on Friday 19 June 2026 and be completed by the start of Term 3.

All work will be done in accordance with work health and safety laws and the NSW Department of Education's Asbestos Management Plan.
