Works notification | 23 May 2024



Dear staff, parents/carers,

We are aware that some external security lights at Ringrose Public School are not working. These lights are mounted on the eaves above the door on the western side of Building G, and on the south-eastern corner of Building D.

Work to replace the lights will involve removing eave sheeting which contains bonded asbestos, as per the school's asbestos register. This means it is attached to another material and cannot be crumbled under light pressure.

Work to replace the eave sheeting and security lights is scheduled for the weekend of Saturday 1 June 2024 and Sunday 2 June 2024.

All work involving asbestos containing materials will take place outside of school hours and air monitoring will be installed by an independent hygienist before work begins.

All work will be done in accordance with work, health and safety laws and the NSW Department of Education's Asbestos Management Plan. All work will be completed by licensed and accredited asbestos contractors and monitored by independent hygienists in strict accordance with applicable legislation, regulations, policies, and guidelines.

The buildings will be inspected by the independent hygienist to confirm they have been fully remediated, and the school will receive a clearance certificate before the areas are reopened.

The health, safety, and wellbeing of the school and local community is our highest priority.
