Works notification | 11 February 2026

Dear staff, parents and carers,

We'd like to share an update following the works notification sent on [26 September 2025](#) regarding the water quality testing at Blaxland East Public School.

Re-testing of the affected water supply outlet by an independent hygienist was recently conducted. The majority of outlets did meet the [Australian Drinking Water Guidelines](#) and are not affected. They continue to be used by students and staff.

Findings have identified trace amounts of lead in samples collected from the bubblers between Building D and G.

As a precautionary safety measure, access to the affected bubblers was restricted. Signage was put in place to remind students and staff not to use these bubblers.

On Wednesday 11 February, the removal of these bubblers from the school grounds began. They will be replaced with a filtered bottle filling station.

The health, safety, and wellbeing of all members of our school and the local community are our highest priorities.
