Works notification | 12 May 2026

Dear staff, parents and carers,

The health, safety, and wellbeing of all members of our school and the local community are our highest priorities.

On Friday 8 May 2026, damage was identified in the eaves of the Building H external movement area at Mannering Park Public School. This area is known to contain bonded asbestos as listed on the School Asbestos Management Plan (SAMP).

As a precaution, the area was immediately isolated and an independent hygienist was engaged to conduct air monitoring and provide advice.

All air monitoring to date across the site has returned results below the minimum detectable limit, which means it is consistent with acceptable levels in ambient air (i.e. <0.01 fibres/mL) as per SafeWork NSW guidelines.

Work to replace the external eaves took place on Saturday 9 May 2026.

All work was done in accordance with work, health and safety laws. All work was completed by experienced contractors and inspected by independent hygienists.
