

Woy Woy South Public School

Works notification | 20 June 2023

Dear staff and parents/carers,

As part of planning for roof replacement at Woy Woy South Public School, some lead containing material was identified within the roof cavity of Buildings K and I. The roof cavities are also on the school's asbestos register as containing asbestos materials.

An independent occupational hygienist has confirmed the buildings remains safe for general occupation as the affected areas are located within the roof cavities, sealed off and therefore inaccessible to students, staff and visitors.

These areas will be remediated before the roof replacement work starts. Work to remediate the materials will take place in 2 stages. Work will start on Saturday 24 June 2023, out of school hours, and will continue during the upcoming winter school holidays.

The remediation work has been scheduled in consultation with school leadership to minimise disruption to teaching and learning.

Safety measures, including air monitoring, will be in place and all work zones will be out of bounds while work is carried out.

All work will be done in accordance with SafeWork NSW regulations and the NSW Department of Education's Asbestos Management Plan. All work will be completed by licensed and accredited contractors and monitored by occupational hygienists in strict accordance with all applicable legislation, regulations, policies, and guidelines.

Affected areas will be inspected by an independent hygienist to confirm it has been fully remediated, and the school will receive a clearance certificate. Following this work, planning for the roof replacement work will be finished. It's expected the roof replacement work will be completed during the winter school holidays.
